

## TITLE: Scarred: Psychological Challenges in an Electrical Burn Survivor

## **ABSTRACT**

Undiagnosed psychiatric disorders among burn patients can negatively impact treatment outcomes. We report a case of a 19-year-old male who suffered from electrical burn injuries involving 30% of the total body surface area. He underwent multiple surgeries including bilateral arm amputations. His recent admission was for release of contractures in the anterior chest and neck area. Patient manifested aggressive behavior in the burn unit post-operation, prompting referral to Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry service.

Patient was diagnosed with Major Depressive Disorder and was started on an antidepressant. In addition, psychological support was rendered. Psychotherapy given focused on the issues of grief, loss and acceptance of self-image, development of adaptive behaviors, enhancing family functioning, and advocating for the patient to the surgical team. Patient's mood improved with no recurrence of aggressive behavior. Moreover, he was noted to be more cooperative with his treatment and other members of the healthcare team.

This case illustrates the importance of psychiatric support alongside medical and surgical treatment for burn survivors, with emphasis on early psychiatric consultation and vigilance in screening for psychiatric conditions.
